



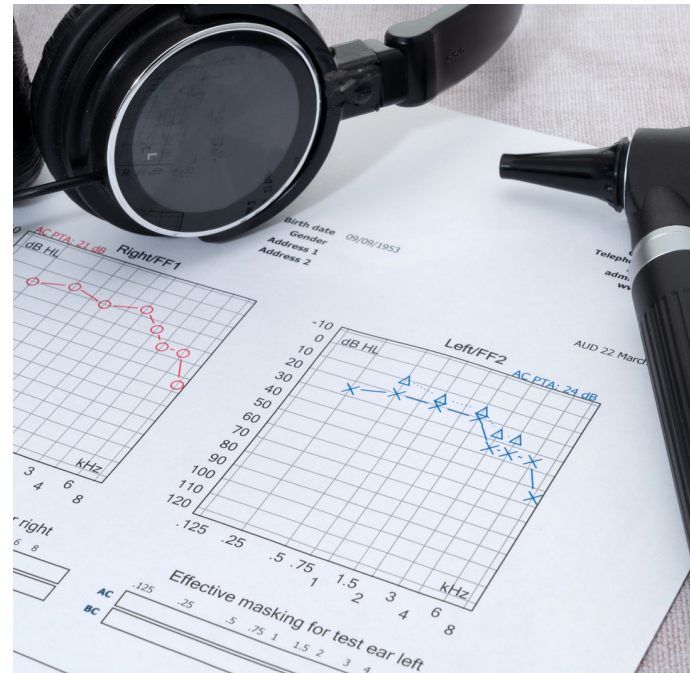

- ☒ Patients requiring medical clearance prior to hearing aid prescription
